For the 27th time, Jazz-Club Trier is organising a jazz workshop. It will take place in the Tuchfabrik (Tufa) in Trier, Wechselstr. 4-6 from 18-21 April.

The workshop kicks off on the evening of Maundy Thursday with the teachers' concert - a good opportunity to experience 'your' teacher in action.

Good Friday, Saturday and Easter Sunday are workshop days, culminating Sunday evening with the Student Concert.

The mornings are dedicated to vocal/instrument classes given by eight professional jazz musicians.

After the lunch break, the students are placed in combos according to their respective musical level, giving each and every student the possibility of being part of a real band.

The afternoons are band rehearsals; each band is under the supervision of a teacher.

On Friday and Saturday evening, there are jam sessions in Tufa where you can try playing 'live' what you have learnt before.

The afternoon bands will take part in the main concert on Easter Sunday evening. Each band will perform a few pieces, and each student will play a solo. This is always a great event and a celebratory end to a busy few days.

There are still a few places available in the solo vocalist, brass and the rhythm groups (the saxophone and bass groups are unfortunately already fully booked!).

The course fee is €140/€110 (non-members/members of Jazz-Club Trier), and includes the entrance fee for the teachers' concert.
